	Annual Impact Report Due: January 2027  Provide at least one (1) real-life impact story and three (3) to five (5) photos (with appropriate consent) that help illustrate the impact of grant funds in the final report. For existing programs, please provide photos at the start of the grant period. Highlight UWSCI's impact by sharing at least one (1) success story through your
_	organization's social media platforms or newsletters throughout the year. In addition, share at least one (1) post in support of UWSCI's annual campaign during the month of September.
	Attend at least 75% of United Way Agency Directors Association (UWADA) meetings within the calendar year.
